

Same-sex marriage in Portugal for Brazilian couples

A practical Same Vibes guide to the official Portuguese legal route

Quick answer

Brazil already has a civil marriage route for same-sex couples. Some Brazilian couples still choose Portugal when they want a managed European route, a Portuguese civil marriage certificate and a process handled before they travel.

Same Vibes checks your case, prepares the document route, coordinates the Portuguese registry process, arranges the interpreter and guides you through one official appointment in Portugal.

After registration, you can leave Portugal the same day officially married, with your Portuguese marriage certificate.

Portugal legal basis: Lei n.º 9/2010. Brazil context: civil marriage between same-sex couples has been available nationwide through the CNJ Resolution 175 framework.

Who this guide is for

This guide is for Brazilian same-sex couples who want a clear, structured and professionally handled civil marriage route in Portugal.

- you are Brazilian or one partner is Brazilian
- you live in Brazil or abroad
- you want an official Portuguese civil marriage certificate
- you want the process prepared before you travel
- you prefer one official registry appointment in Portugal

Key facts

- Portugal allows official civil marriage between same-sex couples.
- Brazilian couples may use Portugal when their documents are prepared correctly for the Portuguese registry route.
- Same Vibes checks the route before you travel.
- The official appointment happens in Portugal.
- In the standard route, you can leave the same day with your Portuguese marriage certificate.
- Apostille, certified translation and delivery can be coordinated separately when needed.

Document route for Brazilian couples

The exact document route depends on citizenship, residence, marital status and the country where each document was issued. Same Vibes checks the route before confirming the process.

| Document or issue | Why it matters | Same Vibes role |
|--|--|---|
| Passports or ID documents | Identify both partners for the Portuguese registry process | We check consistency and explain what to provide |
| Birth certificate | Often part of the marriage document route | We check format, dates, apostille and translation needs |
| Proof of marital status | Shows whether each person is free to marry when required | We check which document route applies |
| Previous divorce or death certificate | Needed if one partner was previously married | We check how the document must be prepared |
| Apostille or legalization | Prepares foreign documents for use in Portugal when needed | We explain what applies to your documents |
| Certified translation | Needed when documents must be used in Portuguese | We coordinate translation requirements when needed |
| Interpreter | Needed at the official appointment when Portuguese is not understood | We arrange the interpreter for the appointment |

How the process works

- 1 Send us your case**
Tell us your citizenships, residence, marital status and document situation.
- 2 We check the route**
Same Vibes reviews whether Portugal is realistic for your Brazilian document route.
- 3 Documents are prepared**
We explain what to prepare, what needs apostille or translation, and what must be corrected before filing.
- 4 Registry process is coordinated**
The Portuguese civil registry process is filed or coordinated before you travel.
- 5 Interpreter is arranged**
When needed, Same Vibes arranges the interpreter for the official appointment.
- 6 You come to Portugal**
You attend one official registry appointment.
- 7 You receive the certificate**
After registration, you can leave the same day officially married with your Portuguese marriage certificate.

Can Brazilian same-sex couples get married in Portugal?

In many cases, yes. The route depends on documents, citizenship, residence and marital status.

Why would a Brazilian couple choose Portugal?

Do we need to live in Portugal?

No. The Same Vibes route is designed for international couples who usually do not live in Portugal.

Can we come for one official appointment?
