

Same-sex marriage in Portugal for French-speaking couples

Who this guide is for

This guide is for French-speaking same-sex couples who want an official civil marriage in Portugal without handling the Portuguese process alone.

Key facts

- Portugal allows official civil marriage between same-sex couples.

Document route for French-speaking couples

French-speaking couples may have documents issued by different countries, civil-status systems or language formats. The goal is to prepare the document route before the couple travels to Portugal.

Interpreter	Supports the official appointment when Portuguese is not understood	We arrange the interpreter for the registry appointment
